Re: Proposed maintenance of Hill Creek Subdivision Roads

The Marshall County Fiscal Court held a public hearing at 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, December 20, 2016 in the Fiscal Courtroom, Marshall County Courthouse, Benton, Kentucky. Duly elected Commissioners Dr. Rick Cocke and Bob Gold and the County Attorney and Assistant County Attorney were present. Kevin Neal, County Judge/Executive presided. Commissioner Johnny Bowlin was absent.

Judge Neal opened the hearing and read the notice, which was published in the December 13, 2016 edition of the Tribune Courier.

Judge Neal then read the Road Viewers Report, which stated all Hill Creek Subdivision Roads (Hill Creek Lane, Creekside Drive, and Hill Creek Court) meet or exceed all requirements for acceptance into county maintenance.

Judge Neal asked, three times, if there was anyone present to speak in favor of the Court accepting Hill Creek Subdivision roads into the County Road Maintenance System. No one spoke.

Judge Neal then asked, three times, if there was anyone present to speak in opposition of the Court accepting Hill Creek Subdivision roads into the County Road Maintenance System. No one spoke.

A motion was made by Com. Cocke and seconded by Com. Gold to close the public hearing. All voted aye. Motion carried.
