

RESOLUTION NO. 2017-02

A Resolution granting Calvert City, Kentucky consent to regulate a "Wellhead Protection Area" located in an unincorporated area just outside the city limits of Calvert City, Kentucky.

WHEREAS, in order to continue to provide its citizens and customers with clean and potable water, Calvert City, Kentucky needs the ability to regulate a particular parcel of land containing its wellheads and the immediately surrounding area;

WHEREAS, this particular parcel of land is currently located in an unincorporated area just outside the city limits of Calvert City, Kentucky;

WHEREAS, KRS 100.131 provides that a fiscal court may grant consent to a city to regulate an unincorporated area within five (5) miles from the city limits;

WHEREAS, the Marshall County Fiscal Court does wish to grant such consent to Calvert City, Kentucky in order to allow the city to regulate the land use immediately around the area of its wellheads;

NOW THEREFORE, Be it Resolved by the Marshall County Fiscal Court as follows:

1. The Marshall County Fiscal Court hereby grants consent to Calvert City, Kentucky to regulate the "Wellhead Protection Area" which is more particularly described in the attachment to this Resolution and is incorporated herein.
2. Consent to regulate shall mean permission is given to Calvert City, Kentucky to regulate the "Wellhead Protection Area" to ensure that clean and potable water is made available to its citizens and customers.
3. The consent granted by this Resolution shall be limited to the specific stated purpose in this Resolution and shall not be interpreted as granting broad regulatory authority beyond the scope and purpose of this Resolution.
