AMENDED ORDINANCE NO. 2022-09

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IN MARSHALL COUNTY, KENTUCKY

WHEREAS, a change was made during the last session of the General Assembly regarding age of employees who may be involved in serving alcohol at licensed establishments;

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Court of Marshall County, Kentucky wishes to amend its ordinance to be in compliance therewith;

NOW THEREFORE, Be it Ordained by the Fiscal Court of Marshall County, Kentucky that Ordinance No. 2022 - 09 is amended as follows:

10.039 CONDITIONS, PROHIBITIONS AND RESTRICTIONS.

- (K) No licensee shall knowingly employ in connection with his or her business any person who:
 - (1) Has been convicted of any felony within the last two (2) years;
- (2) Has been twice convicted of any misdemeanor or offense directly or indirectly attributable to the use of intoxicating liquors within the last two (2) years;
- (3) Is under the age of twenty (20) years who will be serving alcoholic beverages or who will be having any contact whatsoever with the sale of alcohol as defined under state statute;
- (3) Within two (2) years prior to the date of his or her employment, has had any County license under this Ordinance revoked for cause;
 - (4) Age requirements for employees of licensed establishments shall conform to state law;
