**RESOLUTION NO.: 2018-02**

**WHEREAS**, fishing is a multi-billion dollar industry in Kentucky providing an estimated \$1.2 billion in revenues to the Western Kentucky economy alone; and

**WHEREAS**, Kentucky Lake and Lake Barkley are popular fishing destinations that attracts both commercial and recreational fishing, and in so doing, promotes the tourism industry in Kentucky; and

**WHEREAS**, Asian carp have invaded Kentucky and Barkley lakes thereby placing our fishing and tourism industries in jeopardy; and


**WHEREAS**, state officials in Kentucky and Tennessee are in desperate need of additional and federal resources to combat this crisis;
