

**AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE MARSHALL COUNTY
CEMETARY BOARD**

ORDINANCE NO. 04-02

WHEREAS, the Marshall County Fiscal Court is concerned about the condition of the many cemeteries within its borders that have fallen into neglect and disrepair and desires to preserve and maintain these gravesites and cemeteries,

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF THE COUNTY OF MARSHALL, COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY, as follows:

1. In compliance and conjunction with KRS Chapter 67, the Marshall County Cemetery Board (hereafter referred to as the "Board") is hereby established.
2. The Board shall have five (5) members selected by the Marshall County Judge/Executive and approved by the Marshall County Fiscal Court. These members shall serve for four (4) year terms and no more than three (3) members may be in the same political party. However, initial appointment terms shall be as follows: two (2) members appointed to a one (1) year term; two (2) members appointed to two (2) year terms; and one (1) member appointed to a three (3) year term.
3. The Board shall have the authority to act to restore and/or maintain cemeteries that do not receive perpetual care funds pursuant to KRS 367.952
4. The Board shall have the authority to apply for and receive grants in aid from the state and federal governments as well as from any other source that shares the same goals as those set forth in this Ordinance.

THIS ORDINANCE shall become effective immediately upon its passage and publication. This ordinance was adopted pursuant to KRS 67.077 in that it was introduced and read first on the 21st day of January, 2004, was published in summary form on the 4th day of Feb, 2004 was given its second and final reading on the 10th day of Feb, 2004 after which it was passed by a majority vote of the Fiscal Court.
