

AN AMMENDMENT TO THE ORDER OF THE FISCAL COURT OF MARSHALL COUNTY, KENTUCKY, RELATING TO THE ADOPTION AND APPROVAL OF THE MARSHALL COUNTY FISCAL COURT ON NOVEMBER 17, 1970 AND WHICH IS RELATED TO THE IMPOSITION AND PAYMENT OF A TRANSIENT ROOM TAX.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF THE COUNTY OF MARSHALL, COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY, THAT:

The Marshall County Fiscal Court Order dated November 17, 1970, relating to the Transient Room Tax is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION IV


That each person subject to the tax imposed by this resolution and order shall, on or before the 20th day of the month following the close of each month, make and file with the Treasurer of Marshall County or other designated agent of the Fiscal Court, a return, in duplicate, on a form furnished or obtainable from the Treasurer or other designated agent of the Fiscal Court setting forth the aggregate amount of the gross rentals charged during the preceding calendar month for every occupancy of a suite, room or rooms, together with such other pertinent information as the Treasurer may require. Such information shall be of a confidential nature and not be opened to inspection of the public generally but shall be information for the use and benefit of the designated agent or agents of the Fiscal Court and the Treasurer only. Failure to file the report described above on or before the 20th day of the month following the close of each month as provided herein shall constitute a criminal violation, punishable as a violation under the Kentucky Penal Code, provide, however, that failure to comply with this Ordinance shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed \$250.00.
