

# BURN BAN ORDINANCE

COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY  
COUNTY OF MARSHALL  
PROHIBITION OF OUTDOOR BURNING  
ORDINANCE NO. 07- 06

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF MARSHALL COUNTY,  
COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY;

Whereas, outdoor burning during periods of extreme dryness poses a high probability of increased fire risk to properties and person:

Now, therefore, the County of Marshall, hereby, adopts this Ordinance in accordance with the provisions set forth in KRS Title XII, Chapter 149, and,

Whereas, the Marshall County Judge Executive is authorized to issue an Executive Order banning outdoor burning in all unincorporated properties in Marshall County pursuant to KRS Chapter 149.401.

Therefore, any person will be in violation of the Executive Order if he or she burns any flammable or combustible material outside of an enclosure serving to contain all flames and sparks, or orders such burning by others.

Therefore, violations of the Executive Order will be subject to the penalties set forth in KRS Chapter 149.991.


