

2013 TAX RATES

AN ORDINANCE Relating to the adoption of 2013 Marshall County Tax Rates.

WHEREAS, the Marshall County Fiscal Court adopted the 2013 - 2014 fiscal year budget on the 25th day of June, 2013, and

WHEREAS, the Kentucky State Revenue Cabinet has certified the Marshall County property assessments as:

NOW THEREFORE IT IS ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF MARSHALL COUNTY, KENTUCKY:

SECTION ONE. In accordance with KRS 68.245 through 68.249 there is levied for the year 2013 the general ad valorem tax per \$100 assessed valuation on all taxable property within the jurisdiction for the General Fund and such additional tax rates for each Special District or other fund as indicated:

SECTION TWO. In accordance with KRS. 132.487 there is levied for the year 2014 the tax rate of 11.2 cents per hundred dollars (\$100) of the taxable value of motor vehicles/ watercrafts registered in Marshall County.

SECTION THREE. In accordance with KRS. 136.575 there is levied for the year 2013 the tax rate of twenty-five thousandths of one per cent (0.025%) on bank deposits held by all financial institutions within the County of Marshall.

SECTION FOUR. This ordinance shall be published in the Tribune-Courier newspaper by title and summary within thirty (30) days following adoption.

SECTION FIVE. This ordinance becomes effective upon passage and publication.
