Good news—it looks like we will likely get the Interior bill over the finish line. As you know, the legislation contains Leader McConnell's Carp provision. Specifically, it has \$11M, a \$600,000 increase, \$2M of this money is expressly directed to support contract fishing and deterrents to extirpate the Carp (this is new). Kentucky Lake and Barkley are expressly mentioned as areas US Fish should focus these efforts.
