


On January 7, 2020, the Marshall County Fiscal Court convened in executive session to hear the appeal of Tonya Clevidence. The court members heard statements from John Townsend and Chris Freeman indicating that Clevidence had admitted to Freeman that Clevidence did use an IP address associated with Marshall County 911 in an ongoing scheme to harass another individual, in violation of policies and procedures. Clevidence also admitted to the harassment to a Murray Police Detective according to a sworn statement from that detective. The IP addresses matched times when Clevidence was at work and the dates and times of the harassment. Clevidence stated to the court that she should not be terminated because she believed the criminal charges would be dropped, but did not at any point deny the general nature of the allegations. Due to various security concerns and protocols at Marshall County 911, the nature of the offense is such that termination is appropriate due to fear that terminals could be pulled if she is permitted to remain an employee of Marshall County 911.


