Re: Oak Level Cemetery Road

The Marshall County Fiscal Court held a public hearing at 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, August 4, 2020 Fiscal Courtroom, Marshall County Courthouse, Benton, Kentucky. All duly elected Commissioners and the County Attorney were present. Kevin Neal, County Judge/Executive presided.

Judge Neal opened the hearing and read the notice, which was published in the July 28, 2020 edition of the Tribune Courier.


