Marshall County Fiscal Court September 1, 2020

The Marshall County Fiscal Court met in regular session on Tuesday, September 1, 2020 at the Marshall County Courthouse, Benton, Kentucky. Elected Commissioners: Justin Lamb, Kevin Spraggs, Monti Collins, County Attorney Jason Darnall were present. Kevin Neal, County Judge/Executive presided.

I. GUESTS

- B. Economic Development President Josh Tubbs introduced Mitchell Ponder who is the new President of the Kentucky Lake Chamber of Commerce. Mr. Tubbs then updated the court on the Product Development Initiative Grant. He requested a letter from the court supporting the 50 percent match so he can move forward with the grant process.
- C. Parks Director Britney Heath updated the court on the funding for the Miracle League Project. CMS Architects representatives Curt Swinford and Justin Barrett introduced themselves to the court. A motion was made by Com. Collins and seconded by Com. Lamb to approve entering into an agreement with CMS pending the County Attorney's approval of the agreement. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Lamb and seconded by Com. Collins to enter into a contract with Calloway County and the vendor, subject to County Attorney approval. All voted aye. Motion carried.
- F. A motion was made by Com. Spraggs to approve the County Clerk's request to adopt the previous version of the County's Administrative Code. There was no second. Motion dies.
