Judge Neal:

This contract modification request and proposal is being submitted to add additional construction engineering and observation time to our contract to coincide with Murtco's recent submittal for a contract extension for this project. Rivercrest's current contract (including the previous modification) included construction engineering and observation services thru September 4, 2020. While the contractor's progress has been slowed by the unseasonably wet weather and some unforeseen underground conditions, Murtco has staffed the project and work has continued on a weekly basis throughout the contract period.

Throughout construction, Rivercrest has continued to be attentive to and conserved hours where possible to provide the Fiscal Court with the most coverage and support during construction activities. Unfortunately, by the end of August, we had exhausted approximately 90 percent of our allocated time and expenses for construction, and we would like to request that an adjustment be made to our contract to cover additional time and expenses to complete this project. Based on recent discussions with the contractor and our meeting held on September 10th, we anticipate that this project can be fully completed by the end of November 2020. The following includes our proposed fees for supporting the Fiscal Court through the remaining construction activities and closeout of this project:

- As of May, there had been 34 rain days
- MC road dept. was unable to build road to L.S. due to weather
- 2 weeks were lost waiting for shoring system due to Covid-19
- Unable to work at golf course area due to standing water extremely wet conditions.
- Only able to work on water main and force main through much of the winter.

Explanation of Additional Time Extension Request

- 27 rain days since requesting 3-month extension
- Added Megafit sewer line and manhole 10 days
- Additional work at booster station 10 days
- Additional work at L.S. site for over excavation and poor soil conditions - 8 days
- Groundwater and rock excavation at SW1 area 10 days
- Repaired sewer and lateral for city 2 days
- Over excavation and poor soil at road crossing 3 days
- Excessive groundwater and poor soil at interceptor 5 to 10 days
- During the last 90 days Murtco has also completed the remaining work for the MCHS sewer connection to the county and eliminated their wastewater plant. This work was originally scheduled to be completed before Southwest One began, but was delayed due to litigation between the School Board and County.
- Our current forecast is to be completed by approximately 10/31/2020.
- We would like to request an extension through 11/30/2020 to account for any future delays that may occur such as weather or unforeseen ground conditions.
- Booster pump will be operational within the next 2-3 weeks which will allow United Systems building fire line to be calculated and not cause any delays to the building construction.

All work will be completed well ahead of any need by the new building at SW1 Cleanup will be performed late fall and we will return again in spring to complete any unfinished areas or warranty spots.
