The Marshall County Fiscal Court met in for a Special Called meeting on Thursday, January 14, 2021 at the Marshall County Courthouse, Benton, Kentucky. Elected Commissioners: Justin Lamb, Kevin Spraggs, Monti Collins, County Attorney Jason Darnall were present. Kevin Neal, County Judge/Executive presided.

Judge Neal called court to order at 10:41 AM.

- I. Billy Pitts, Marshall County Health Department Director updated the court on the status of the Covid vaccines including number of vaccines ordered and available and the stages in which they are to be administered.
- II. A motion was made by Com. Collins and seconded by Com. Lamb to approve the contract modification from Rivercrest Engineering for \$10,800. All voted aye Motion carried.
- III. A motion was made by Com. Collins and seconded by Com. Lamb to approve E911 new hire Hope Oliver at \$13.70 effective 1/28/2021. All voted aye. Motion carried.
- IV. A motion was made by Judge Neal and seconded by Com. Lamb to approve the Sheriff's Annual Order Setting Maximum Amount for Deputies and Assistants at \$2,845,000. Judge Neal voted yes, Com. Lamb voted yes, Com. Collins voted yes, Com. Spraggs voted no. Motion carried.
- V. A motion was made by Com. Collins and seconded by Com. Lamb to approve the Marshall County Sheriff's Budget, Cumulative Report and Annual Settlement for Calendar Year 2021. All voted aye. Motion carried.
- VI. A motion was made by Judge Neal and seconded by Com. Lamb to approve the Marshall County Clerk's Annual Order Setting Maximum Amount for Deputies and Assistants at \$830,000. Judge Neal voted yes, Com. Lamb voted yes, Com. Collins voted yes, Com. Spraggs voted no. Motion carried.
- VII. A motion was made by Com. Lamb and seconded by Com. Collins to approve the Marshall County Clerk's Budget for Calendar Year 2021 adjusted less \$50,000. Judge Neal voted yes, Com. Lamb voted yes, Com. Collins voted yes, Com. Spraggs voted no. Motion carried.
- VIII. Judge Neal asked if there was any reason to deny current bills and claims. The bills and claims are to be paid.
- IX. A motion was made by Com. Lamb and seconded by Com. Spraggs to adjourn. All voted aye. Motion carried.
