

Marshall County Fiscal Court  
March 16, 2021

The Marshall County Fiscal Court met for a Regular Called Meeting on Tuesday, March 16, 2021 at the Marshall County Courthouse, Benton, Kentucky. Elected Commissioners: Justin Lamb, Monti Collins, Kevin Spraggs, County Attorney Jason Darnall were present. Judge Neal presided.

Judge Neal called court to order at 9:30 A.M.

I. GUESTS

A. Glenn Denton from Denton Law Firm addressed the court regarding various aspects of employment law and his opinion on the County's Administrative Code as well as the Sheriff and Jailer's Administrative Codes.

B. Michael Oliver with the Kentucky Department of Transportation presented the 2021-2022 Rural Secondary Recommendations for District 1 totaling \$1,057,739.

C. Deborah Blankenship from Life Associates presented several options for life insurance. A motion was made by Com. Lamb and seconded by Com. Spraggs to accept the proposal of 1x salary/\$50,000 with employee option to purchase additional coverage. All voted aye. Motion carried.

D. Parks Director Britney Hargrove and Curt Swinford from CMS Architects presented the Opinion of Cost for the Miracle League field including items to bid, in house expenses, and grant applications. A motion was made by Com. Collins and seconded by Com. Spraggs for CMS to create the design for bids and to advertise for bids. All voted aye. Motion carried.

E. A motion was made by Com. Lamb and seconded by Com. Spraggs to recess. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Judge Neal called court back to order.

II. CORRESPONDENCE

A. Deputy Judge Brad Warning read the letter from the Attorney General's Office regarding the donation to the Marshall County Parks Department to be used at the Aurora Community Park.

III. OLD BUSINESS

A. A motion was made by Com. Lamb and seconded by Com. Collins to approve the minutes of the March 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting. All voted aye. Motion carried.

B. A motion was made by Com. Lamb and seconded by Com. Collins to approve and adopt Ordinance #2021-01 Budget Amendment. All voted aye. Motion carried.

C. A motion was made by Com. Spraggs and seconded by Com. Lamb to accept the mowing bid from Cedar Ridge Property Maintenance for \$15,800 for the 2021 mowing season. All voted aye. Motion carried.

IV. NEW BUSINESS

A. A motion was made by Com. Lamb and seconded by Com. Collins to sign the Designation of Applicant's Agent Resolution for Emergency Management. All voted aye. Motion carried.

B. A motion was made by Com. Collins and seconded by Com. Lamb to advertise for annual bids. All voted aye. Motion carried.

C. A motion was made by Com. Lamb and seconded by Com. Collins to allow the West Kentucky Educational Cooperative to place two signs at the courthouse to advertise their GED classes. All voted aye. Motion carried.

D. A motion was made by Com. Collins and seconded by Com. Lamb to approve Judge Neal's training incentive for \$4,372.96. All voted aye. Motion carried.

E. A motion was made by Com. Lamb and seconded by Com. Collins to sign the Memorandum of Understanding between Marshall County Sanitation and Marshall County Board of Education. All voted aye. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Com. Lamb and seconded by Com. Collins to approve the \$200 per pay period wage increase for Marshall County Sanitation employees as stated in the Memorandum of Understanding reimbursable at \$1,908.33 per month. All voted aye. Motion carried.


A motion was made by Com. Collins and seconded by Com. Spraggs to approve salary compensation retroactive to February 1, 2021 for Sanitation employees. All voted aye. Motion carried.

F. A motion was made by Com. Collins and seconded by Com. Spraggs to approve the transfer. All voted aye. Motion carried.

G. Judge Neal asked if there was any reason to deny current bills and claims. The bills and claims are to be paid.

H. A motion was made by Com. Spraggs and seconded by Com. Collins to adjourn. All voted aye. Motion carried.
