

Marshall County Fiscal Court
May 18, 2021

The Marshall County Fiscal Court met for a Regular Called Meeting on Tuesday, May 18, 2021 at the Marshall County Courthouse, Benton, Kentucky. Elected Commissioners: Justin Lamb, Monti Collins, Kevin Spraggs, County Attorney Jason Darnall were present. Judge Neal presided.

Judge Neal called court to order at 9:33 A.M.

I. GUESTS

A. A motion was made by Com. Collins and seconded by Com. Lamb to approve the Participation Agreement between the Marshall County Fiscal Court and the Delta Regional Authority with amendments as follows: remove Section 1:k and l, Section 6:a and b. All voted aye. Motion carried.
