

Marshall County Fiscal Court  
Special Called Meeting  
October 12, 2021

The Marshall County Fiscal Court met for a Regular Meeting on Tuesday, October 12, 2021 at the Marshall County Courthouse, Benton, Kentucky. Elected Commissioners: Justin Lamb, Kevin Spraggs, Monti Collins, County Attorney Jason Darnall were present. Judge Neal presided.

Judge Neal called court to order at 9:34 A.M.

I. GUESTS

A. DJ Story with Peel & Holland presented the health plan renewal. A motion was made by Com. Collins and seconded by Com. Lamb to approve the Benefit Advisory Services Agreement with Peel & Holland. All voted aye. Motion carried.
