The Marshall County Fiscal Court met for a regular meeting on Tuesday, February 15, 2022 at the Marshall County Courthouse, Benton, Kentucky. Elected Commissioners: Justin Lamb, Kevin Spraggs, Monti Collins, County Attorney Jason Darnall were present. Judge Neal presided.

- B. Chad McCann with Rivercrest Engineering presented the proposal for the Hunter Road and Walnut Church Grove Road water main \extensions that will be funded with ARPA funds. These projects will extend current Hardin lines to the end of Benton lines and connect them, as well as upgrade current water lines. A motion was made by Com. Lamb and seconded by Com. Collins to approve the Rivercrest Engineering proposal for Walnut Grove Church Road and Hunter Road. All voted aye. Motion carried.
- C. Laurel Matula with ER Assist provided a county update on disaster clean up. Debris cleanup is almost finished in the county. The final date to have debris to the road for pickup is March 10th. A motion was made by Com. Collins and seconded by Com. Spraggs to pick up and cover the cost, up to \$10,000, the debris on private roads if that request is denied by FEMA. All voted aye. Motion carried. FEMA has started site visits for temporary housing needs. The Long Term Recovery Committee has been put in place to work with tornado victims.
