BYPASS IN MEMORY OF SCOTT NATHAN JONES**

WHEREAS, Lt. Scott Nathan Jones was veteran of the armed services, having dedicated 18 years of his life in the United States Navy;

WHEREAS, Lt. Scott Nathan Jones was a valuable first responder, having spent 29 years with multiple fire departments, including the Fairdealing-Olive Fire Department where he achieved the rank of Lieutenant;

WHEREAS, Lt. Scott Nathan Jones was a teacher and mentor to many other first responders as a fire instructor for the Commonwealth of Kentucky;

WHEREAS, Lt. Scott Nathan Jones tragically died way too soon on April 26, 2021, in an accident on U.S. Highway 641 Bypass in Marshall County, Kentucky;

WHEREAS, his death left a huge hole in the hearts of all of the friends and family who loved him;

WHEREAS, his death left a void in the first responder community, having lost a brother, a friend, a firefighter, a teacher, a mentor, a leader, and an outspoken advocate for fire safety;

WHEREAS, Lt. Scott Nathan Jones was known for his kindness, generosity, smile, and faithful service to his community and his country;

WHEREAS, Lt. Scott Nathan Jones will be greatly missed;
