The Marshall County Fiscal Court met for a Special Called Meeting on Tuesday, May 31, 2022 at the Marshall County Courthouse, Benton, Kentucky. Elected Commissioners Justin Lamb, Kevin Spraggs, Monti Collins were present. Kevin Neal, County Judge/Executive presided.

Judge Neal called court to order at 8:39 A.M.

- I. Judge Neal updated the court on the sewer line running down 641 from Draffenville to Catfish kitchen. The pump has burned out so the District is pumping out sewer for 7 or 8 residents. Marshall County Sanitation District Chairman Randy Green is waiting on more info from Rivercrest Engineering for repair and/or replacement. This item will be discussed again at the next regular court meeting.
- II. A TVA Invest Prep Grant was submitted last Friday, May 27 for Southwest One alternate entrance. This is the third application for the entrance and signage. The grant is up to \$750,000 and is a 70/30 match if awarded and would require the court to contribute \$165,000. A motion was made by Com. Collins and seconded by Com. Lamb to move forward with the grant process. All voted aye. Motion carried.
- III. A motion was made by Com. Collins and seconded by Com. Lamb to adjourn. All voted aye. Motion carried.
