The Marshall County Fiscal Court met for a regular meeting on Tuesday, January 16, 2024 at the Marshall County Courthouse, Benton, Kentucky. Elected Commissioners Eddie McGuire, Marty Barrett, Monti Collins and County Attorney Jason Darnall were present. Judge Spraggs presided.
